Last year, Russ Burden's presentation "Cherished Spectacles of Nature" was a big hit with our members. Russ's photographic skills and his sense of humor combine to create an entertaining evening. Those of you who have visited his website

know that he leads nature tours throughout the United States in locations from Florida to Oregon. During the question and answer session after last year's presentation there appeared to be considerable interest in Russ's Tanzanian Photography so in October Russ will give a two part presentation entitled, "Under Tanzanian Skies." Part 1 is a 15-20 minute "How To" Key-note show that demonstrates his fondness for Tanzania. It includes a tutorial of photos that depict his most common tour mottos: It's All About The Light, Edit Before Pressing the Shutter, Exhaust All Possibilities, Watch For Those Blinkies, and more..... You will be shown examples of images that illustrate what to do before pressing the shutter so you can make award winning safari and wildlife images. Part 2 is a 20 minute presentation of Russ's safari photos set to music.

As in the past, I encourage you to visit Russ's' website before the presentation. In addition I know many of you receive Russ's photo tips and may have questions about various topics. Russ enjoys answering your questions and I'm anticipating another post presentation Q & A as lively as last years.

Submitting Pictures for the Monthly Competition or Photo Review Session

- Log on to the LPS.CC website
- Mouse over the Competitions dropdown on the Home Page.
- Select menu item:

- Select the Competition or the Third Monday Photo Review
- Click the **Select** button on the Left side.
- At the bottom of the screen, click on **Upload images into the Competition.**
- Then click on the button **Select** which will open a window on your computer to select images.
- Click on **Save Images**

The monthly competitions allow a single image per competition.

The photo review session allows up to two images — title the images with the letters A and B followed by your last name. That will allow us to limit the number of images if necessary.



As a result, they spend hours on the computer trying to optimize the photo. Award winning photographer, teacher and instructional tour director, Russ Burden, will share his expertise on how he masters the shot in the moment during this month's Loveland Photographic Society meeting.

Lack of experience can cause frustration when trying to take the perfect shot. Russ is known for directing nature photography tours that have resulted in award winning photography for those who have participated. He shares knowledge that has been acquired from 27 years experience as a photography teacher and work that has been published internationally.

Working the camera is only half the battle. Knowing the best time to approach the environment is where all of the magic happens in nature photography. Prior students have shared numerous testimonials about how Russ has shown them strategy to master light and capture animals in amazing natural settings. He even received the nickname, "Dr. Doolittle" during one of his excursions due to his ability to attract and direct animals during the session "almost on cue."
